Development Applications

All development within the Town must conform to the Town's Basic Planning Statement and Zoning Bylaw 9-2013. Application forms are available at the town office and **no development** shall take place until a permit is issued by the Development Officer.

While there are some exceptions to the bylaw, you should check with the Town office before commencing **any** development, be it earthwork, building a structure, fence or pool.

For your information there can only be one accessory (shed) building per property.

Attention Pet Owners !

Council reminds you to review the regulations outlined in our Dog & Cat Bylaw 11-2014 and act responsibly to ensure that your pets are not bothering your neighbours.

- No household shall keep more than three dogs or cats
- All dogs and cats are required to have a lifetime license which costs \$20.00 if your pet is spayed or neutered.
- No dogs shall be allowed to run at large
- Please keep your animals from making excessive noise and last but not least **Please clean up after your pet !**

Compost Site

The compost site will be open as of **April 5, 2016** for branches, leaves and grass.

Line Flushing

There will be main water line flushing the week of April 18 - 22, 2016, weather permitting. This may result in a short loss of water pressure or service. You may wish to run your water tap for a short while once service is resumed if you notice any discoloration.

We also recommend that you don't do any laundry or use bleach between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
