- Beware of special offers. If you are told that you were "specially selected" to receive something like a free prize, remember that nothing is free.

## Protect Your Elm Trees

- To reduce the risk of Dutch elm disease (DED), pruning of elm trees will once again be prohibited from April 1 to August 31.
- Proper elm tree pruning outside the annual Provincial ban helps keep trees healthy and better able to resist all diseases, including DED. Removing dead and dying elm wood through pruning also helps reduce places for beetles to breed, and curbs their population.
- Band elm trees to protect them against DED. Bands can go on September Long Weekend and come off by May Long Weekend.
