A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND GOVERN THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES IN THE TOWN OF KIPLING

The Council of the Town of Kipling in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 4-77, a bylaw to control and regulate the discharge of firearms within the Town of Kipling is hereby repealed.
- 2. No person or persons shall fire or discharge any air or pellet gun, use any class of guns, firearms or other devices that are designed for or capable of discharging projectiles of any type within the limits of the Town of Kipling except as provided elsewhere in this bylaw.
- 3. For the purpose of pest control only, the Pest Control Officer, duly appointed by Council, shall be authorized to discharge a firearm within the Town limits.

PENALTY CLAUSE FOR VOLUNTARY PAYMENT

- 4. No person shall:
 - a) Fail to comply with an order made pursuant to this Bylaw;
 - b) Obstruct or interfere with any Designated Officer or any other person acting under the authority of this Bylaw; or
 - c) Fail to comply with any other provision of this Bylaw
- 5. Where the Designated Officer believes that a person has contravened any provision of this Bylaw, he may serve upon such person a Bylaw Violation Notice as provided by this section either personally or by mailing or leaving same at his last known address and such service shall be adequate for the purpose of this Bylaw.

- 6. Such notice shall be deemed to have been served:
 - a) On the expiration of twenty-four hours after it is posted, if the notice is mailed
 - b) On the day of actual delivery, if the notice is served personally; or
 - c) On the business day following the transmission, if given by facsimile
- 7. A Bylaw Violation Notice shall be in such form as determined in the Towns General Penalty, Enforcement and Voluntary Payment of Fines Bylaw, Schedule A, and shall state the section of the Bylaw, which was contravened, and the amount, which is provided in Schedule A that will be accepted by the Municipality in lieu of prosecution.
- 8. Where the Municipality receives voluntary payment of the amount prescribed under Section 7 within the time specified, the person receiving the Notice of Violation shall not be liable to prosecution for the alleged contravention.
- 9. Upon production of a Bylaw Violation Notice issued pursuant to this section within thirty (30) days from the issue thereof, together with the payment of the fee as provided in Schedule A to the Town of Kipling, the person to whom the ticket was issued shall not be liable for prosecution for the contravention in respect of which the ticket was issued.
- 10. Payment of any Notice of Violation does not exempt the person from enforcement of an order pursuant to Section 10 of this Bylaw.
- 11. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, a person to whom a Bylaw Violation Notice has been issued pursuant to this section may exercise his right to defend any charge of committing a contravention of any of the provisions of the Bylaw.
- 12. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw shall be liable to damage costs related to the offence and a fine as per the General Penalty, Enforcement and Voluntary Payment of Fines Bylaw 10-2010 of the Town of Kipling.
