## TOWN OF KIPLING BYLAW NO. 5-2019



## A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 9-2013 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Kipling in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 9-2013 C2 – Highway Commercial District Section 8(3) as follows:

- 1. By adding under Section 5.7 of the Zoning Bylaw 9-2013, Figure 14 Permitted/Discretionary Uses in the C2 District: "Dwelling, Single Detached" as a Discretionary Use.
- 2. By adding a Section 5.7.10 under 5.7.9 as follows: "In addition to those items listed in 2.6.13 of this bylaw, for the purpose of evaluating a single detached dwelling in this zone, Council shall also consider the following criteria:
  - Compatibility with nearby and existing land uses,
  - Previously existing land uses on the site,
  - Landscape and buffering measures to ensure compatibility with adjacent uses (refer to 2.6.1,3)
  - Traffic Flow (refer to 2.6.13),
  - Section 6.3 of the Official Community Plan."
- 3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day adopted by Council the final passing thereof.
