

**TOWN OF KIPLING
BYLAW NO. 2-2003**

**A BYLAW TO REGULATE SMOKING IN CERTAIN
PUBLIC FACILITIES IN THE TOWN OF KIPLING.**

WHEREAS it has been determined that second hand tobacco smoke and side-stream smoke from idling cigarettes, cigars and pipes is a health hazard and discomfort for the inhabitants of the Town of Kipling, and

WHEREAS it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Kipling to regulate smoking in certain public facilities;

NOW THEREFORE in accordance with Section 142 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984, the Council of the Town of Kipling in the Province of Saskatchewan enact as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:

a) "Facility" means the Kipling Arena, the Kipling Community Center and Town Office Complex, Kipling Water Treatment Plant, and the Kipling Swimming Pool, Sewage Lift Station, Kipling Fire Hall Library Office Complex, Equipment maintenance shop, and Kipling Golf Course.

b) "Smoking includes:

- (i) lighting of a cigar, cigarette, pipe or other smoking equipment:
- (ii) carrying or smoking of lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other smoking equipment and "smoke" has a corresponding meaning:

2. No person shall smoke at any time in any part of a facility specified in Section 1(a).

(a) the designated area is,

(i) at the Kipling Arena, Curling Club Lounge, subject to compliances of the Alcohol and Gaming Regulations Act

(ii) at the Kipling Community Center Complex, out doors

(iii) at the Kipling Water Treatment Plant, outdoors

(iv) at the Kipling Swimming Pool, outside of fenced area.

(v) at the Kipling Sewage Lift Stations, outdoors

(vi) at the Fire Hall, Library, Office Complex out doors

(vii) at the Equipment Maintenance Shop, outdoors

(viii) at the Kipling Golf Course, outdoors.
