

KIPLING RINK MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE COVID-19 PLAN

All ice times must be booked through the Rec Office.

STAY HOME AND AWAY FROM OTHERS IF

- You are showing symptoms or feeling unwell
- You have travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days
- You have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or are waiting for test results for COVID-19

MASKS AND FACE COVERINGS

We **strongly recommend** masks to be worn whenever you are not actively engaging in a physical activity. This includes:

- In change rooms
- In the lobby
- When moving from one area to another in the facility
- If you are coaching
- If you are a **spectator**

This will be subject to change to mirror any National, Provincial or Municipal Council policy.

KIPLING RINK MANAGEMENT WILL

- Ensure we are aligned with provincial guidelines
- Clean and disinfect high touch areas regularly (e.g. doors, counters, handles)
- Provide access to hand sanitizer
- Staff will maintain physical distancing

USER GROUPS WILL

- Make sure their participants understand the COVID-19 guidelines
- Follow their provincial and national sport governing bodies' guidelines related to COVID-19

- Adhere to any special guidelines as outlined by the Town of Kipling or Kipling Rink Management Committee
- Limit the number of contacts between different participants by playing within set cohort groups (e.g. mini-leagues or groups with a fixed number of participants)
- Ensure their participants bring their own water
- Collect participant contact information to support contact tracing, in the event it becomes necessary. This includes the names of accompanying supports/spectators of participants.
- Follow guidelines for indoor and outdoor gatherings.
- Help coaches and instructors reinforce messages about physical distancing (2 metres/6 ft apart, where possible) and limiting physical contact – no close contact huddles, no handshakes, no high fives.
- Manage their groups/teams to ensure as little time as possible is spent in the facility (including change rooms). Players are required to arrive no more than **15 minutes** prior to their scheduled time, and leave no more than **15 minutes** after their ice time ends.
- Frequently sanitize and disinfect any equipment handled by hand (e.g. hockey sticks, pucks, goalie equipment).
- Coaches and Program Leaders will designate one or more people per dressing room as “**sanitation champions**” to be responsible for ensuring the dressing room high touch areas (benches, door handles, light switches, taps, soap dispensers, hand towel dispensers, toilet handle and seat) be sanitized after the team vacates the dressing room. Sanitation supplies will be available in each dressing room.
- Each team/group will be required to sign this 2020/21 Season COVID-19 Guidelines and Waiver at least 7 days prior to their first on ice activity.

PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS WILL

- Maintain physical distancing where possible and wear masks (strongly recommended). Masks will not be worn when participating in intense physical activity.
- Wash hands with soap and water before, during and after activities
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth and face.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue or elbow.
- Carry and use their own hand sanitizer – hand sanitizer will be provided and entry to the facility.
- Players should come dressed in gear as much as possible.
- No sharing of equipment, unless players are from same household. No sharing of water bottles or towels.
- Arrive no sooner than 15 minutes before scheduled activity time.

- No gathering or loitering in dressing rooms or public areas before, during or after activity.
- Ensure all garbage and recycling is placed in appropriate bins.
- Spectators are required to practice physical distancing in all spectator areas. Spectator stands will not be disinfected and cleaned in between bookings
- Spectators are expected to stay away from dressing rooms and play surfaces, unless required to support players (in case of injury); physical distancing guidelines still to be followed.
- Leave the Kipling Arena as soon as activity ends to reduce overlap of people in facility.
- Each team will be required to sign the 2020/21 Season COVID-19 Guidelines and Waiver at least 7 days prior to first on ice activity scheduled.

RECORD OF PARTICIPANTS

Each team or organization using the Kipling Arena shall record each participant / parent / guardian / supporting spectator attending a practice or game, both arriving and vacating the facility. Records must be kept for 30 days and be made available to the Town of Kipling and Kipling Rink Management upon request.

ARENA SPECIFIC MEASURES

- Water fountains and vending machines will not be available
- Faucets in all washrooms to be used only for washing hands
- Spectator stands will not be disinfected and cleaned between every practice and game
- Dressing rooms are open, but physical distancing measures are in place; players should come dressed in gear as much as possible. Masks are strongly recommended by non-players where physical distancing is not possible
- Shower facilities are not available; players will shower at home
- User Groups are expected to maintain cohort groups in dressing rooms
- Maximum of spectators limited to 30 people per team in facility at one time.
- No more than gatherings of 30 in each set of stands or space.
- Facility Capacity shall be determined with the following priority:
 1. Saskatchewan Health Authority Guidelines
 2. Town of Kipling and Kipling Rink Management Guidelines
 3. Provincial Sport Governing Body Guidelines

NOTE:

- Maximum number of people allowed in facility may change as Saskatchewan Health Authority restrictions change.
